2006-2007

President Cigarroa has spent considerable time in preparation for the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools accreditation in 2008. As part of this program, he successfully put 100% of the faculty members' curriculum vitae into an electronic format which has many advantages for building collaborations. He has also developed quality enhancement programs for all aspects of the campus. A comprehensive strategic plan was developed over a 2-year period and has been approved by the Office of Health Affairs. This plan is now being implemented.

President Cigarroa spent substantial effort in the preparation of a clinical translational science award application, which will bear important fruit for collaboration even if it should not be funded in this round of proposals. He successfully recruited Dr. Tyler Curiel as Director of the San Antonio Cancer Center, Dr. Francis Giles as the new Chief of Hematology Oncology, Dr. Chul Ha as the new Chair of Radiation Oncology and Dr. Amelie Ramirez as the Director for Cancer Prevention Programs and Health Disparities. These are excellent appointments of individuals who can work closely with the recently recruited Dean of the Medical School, William Henrich.

With advice from Randa Safady, President Cigarroa reorganized the Office of Development and External Relations. He has also launched a "branding campaign" for the Health Science Center throughout south Texas. An important \$25 million gift from the Greehey family was accomplished during this past year. Important other fundraising opportunities are at hand.

President Cigarroa has been an important leader for the Regional Academic Health Center, the Laredo Campus Extension and the Borderplex Council.

Ground has been broken for the construction of a new comprehensive ambulatory center and plans are developing for specific health care programs to attract patients. Implementation of the EPIC System for electronic medical records is underway.

With his new recruitments and enhanced fund raising program, President Cigarroa has galvanized the enthusiasm of the faculty, staff and students at UT Health Science Center at San Antonio. The school continues to be among the largest sources of Hispanic physicians in the United States. This year it led the country in the number of Hispanic physician graduates. Its programs in South Texas to encourage interest in careers as nurses and physicians are exemplary.

President Cigarroa received the Dr. Ignacio Chávez Medal of Merit from the National University of Mexico in February 2007. He also received the Hispanic Health Leadership Award in the academic category from the National Hispanic Medical Association in Washington, D.C. in March 2007.

President Cigarroa is an exemplary community leader and is currently chair of the Chamber of Commerce for Bexar County. President Cigarroa has employed a professional recruiting team to find a chief operating officer for the campus who should be recruited in the summer of 2007 and it has prepared a recruiting package for the new Chairman of the Department of Medicine, which is a critical component to the future success of the campus. This requirement will require considerable financial resources. He has had an outstanding year as President of this campus.
